



The State Motor Vehicle Crash Dashboard is now available to state traffic safety partners

The National EMS Information System ([NEMESIS](https://nemsis.org)) and NHTSA's Office of EMS have made access to the state-specific Motor Vehicle Crash Dashboard available to approved traffic safety data partners.

This interactive report provides up-to-date information about EMS responses to MVCs including patient demographics, types of MVC-related injuries, injury severity, trauma center criteria, ambulance response times, drug/alcohol involvement, and more.

Access to a state dashboard is authorized solely by the state Office of EMS Director or Data Manager. NEMESIS does not approve access.

How to request permission for access:

1. A submit a written request to support@nemsis.atlassian.net
2. The request must include the following information:
 - a. Subject: Request for Access to State MVC Dashboard
 - b. First and last name
 - c. Organization and your title
 - d. The single state for which you are requesting access
 - e. The purpose of your interest in state-specific MVC data
 - f. Business email address
 - g. Business phone number
3. The NEMESIS Technical Assistance Center will review the request and contact the appropriate state EMS official. Access is granted ONLY by the recognized state EMS official and not by NEMESIS.
4. If approved by the state, the NEMESIS TAC will create a user account and provide connection information to the requester.
