

## 2023 PUBLIC-RELEASE RESEARCH DATASET NOW AVAILABLE



## 54,190,579 EMS Activations 14,369 EMS Agencies 54 States and Territories

The National Emergency Medical Services Information System Technical Assistance Center (NEMSIS TAC) announced today the availability of the 2023 Public-Release Research Dataset, the largest publicly available dataset of emergency medical service activations in the United States.

The 2023 Public-Release Research Dataset is a subset of the National EMS Database, a repository for EMS data collected from U.S. States and Territories. NEMSIS maintains the national standard for how patient care information, resulting from an emergency 911 call for medical assistance, is collected. The dataset includes 54,190,579 EMS activations submitted by 14,369 EMS agencies servicing 54 states and territories.
