The 2022 Public-Release Research Dataset is Available

The TAC is grateful to all state data managers, software vendor companies, and EMS clinicians for the timely submission of patient care records (PCR's) completed during 2022. The records have been cleaned and aggregated and are now available in the 2022 Public-Research Dataset. The dataset includes 51,379,493 EMS activations submitted by 13,946 EMS agencies servicing 54 states and territories.

The 2022 Public-Release Research Dataset, the largest publicly available dataset of emergency medical service activations in the United States. With the release of the Public-Research Dataset, NEMSIS aims to improve understanding of, confidence in, and support for EMS data collection and analysis that will lead to improved patient care.

NEMSIS User Accounts Participation

The NEMSIS TAC is migrating to a cloud infrastructure, and we are increasing our security measures. One of the changes is that User Accounts will require an organizational email address. The NEMSIS User Accounts policy has been updated to reflect new security standards. The User Accounts are now set to expire after 6 months of inactivity, and users need to reset their passwords every 90 days. States and Vendors are responsible for maintaining who they have authorized for access to their restricted data by notifying the TAC when a User Account needs to be disabled. At the request of State Offices of EMS, the sunset date for v3.4 data was extended by 12 months to January 2024.

States are encouraged to implement the v3.5 data standard as soon as they are able. EMS software vendors continue to develop products to support the v3.5 standard.


